



Note: Vinyl flooring products not adequately sealed will attack any rubber mat. The plasticizers in the vinyl will attack the color stabilizers in the rubber causing a discoloration of the vinyl floor. However, vinyl flooring products that are totally sealed would be warranted against this issue and are best suited for commercial environments.

Are your floors compatible with the Autoclavable Mat? They are if you have the following type of floor:

- Ceramic, Terra Cotta or stone tiles,
- Terrazzo,
- Sealed Paint,
- Rubber, or
- Sealed Vinyl or Linoleum

If you have a vinyl floor that attacks the rubber and causes a stain, acetone based cleaners such as mineral spirits should remove or at least lighten the discoloration. If possible, please test the cleaner on an uninstalled tile to make sure that the cleaner does not harm the product.
