

POWERHOUSE™ Cable Protection System

POWERHOUSE is a cable/hose management system intended to reduce the possibility of damage to cables and hose

lines that are subject to pedestrian and vehicular traffic. It is intended for temporary installations only and must be in accordance with all applicable electrical, building and safety codes. **DO NOT** use electrical connectors or splices within this system.

CAUTION: MISUSE CAN LEAD TO ELECTRICAL SHOCK AND INJURY

- Use only on a stable level surface. Inclined surfaces, slippery surfaces and broken/uneven ground can cause injury or damage to the parts.
- Avoid concentrated loads. Load-supporting capacity varies by type of loading conditions. Differences in wheel diameter and width will affect capacity. A smaller wheel will cause more stress, lowering the capacity. Environmental conditions also affect capacity. The load capacity decreases in warm environments and especially low temps can cause damage to the system.
- Vehicular traffic must pass over this system slowly.
- This system can be a trip hazard to pedestrian traffic when they are unaware of its presence.
- Keep the POWERHOUSE cable/hose management system clean and bright so it will be more visible.
- DO NOT use as work surface. NO CUTTING, NO DRILLING, NO HAMMERING.
- POWERHOUSE is not intended for static loads. DO NOT place ladders, scaffolds, or any type of structure on the system.
- Various services, communications, fluids and power should be in separate channels.
- Plastics can be attacked by some chemicals. Always test for chemical compatibility before using and follow maintenance instructions.

MAINTENANCE

- Store in a clean dry area.
- Inspect parts and replace if damaged. Remove any foreign materials and clean out any liquids. Keep clean with a detergent and water solution.

WARRANTY DETAILS

The materials and workmanship of POWERHOUSE™ Cable Protection products are backed by a 3-year warranty under normal indoor conditions, and 1-year under normal outdoor conditions. If the purchaser discovers a defect in the materials or workmanship of a POWERHOUSE™ Cable Protector, Wearwell, LLC. will, at its own discretion, either:

- i.) repair the nonconforming product
- ii.) replace the product with the same or substantially similar product, or
- iii.) reimburse the buyer for the purchase price of the nonconforming product based on the expected useful life of the product

Wearwell reserves the right to inspect the non-conforming part(s) before repairing, replacing or reimbursing the buyer. Therefore, at the preference of Wearwell LLC, the part must be returned or available for on-site inspection. The product must be installed, used and maintained according to the instructions and procedures provided, or this warranty is void. Any modification of the product will also void this warranty. **THE OBLIGATION UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS LIMITED TO THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF DEFECTIVE PRODUCTS.**
